Please Note:

(1) MDE = Multidisciplinary Evaluation

(2) IFSP = Individualized Family Service Plan

(3) Children can be evaluated and found eligible in one county and have an IFSP in another county.

(4) General services include direct services, such as physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech language pathology, and special instruction. Evaluations and service coordinations are not included.

(5) The sum of the counts by county does not equal the statewide or New York City totals because children move and are counted in each county in which they resided, but are only counted once in a given year in the totals.
