Keep Out Carbon Monoxide When Enjoying the Outdoors.

Campers, hunters, ice fishermen, and anglers risk carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning when burning fuel in enclosed spaces.

Keep these outside and away from enclosed spaces and sleeping areas.



Grills



Portable generators



Charcoal



Camp stoves & heaters

Set up your tent or camper far away from any car or generator.



Do not pitch a tent near a car's exhaust pipe.



Early signs of CO poisoning are headaches, dizziness, nausea, weakness, or confusion. Leave the area immediately, get fresh air, and call 911.
