## **OVERVIEW OF PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Public Advisory and Oversight Panel PPS Mid-Point Assessment Meeting January 31, 2017

## I. Highlights

- A. Twenty-eight individuals representing 14 agencies provided public comment
- B. Among the over 80 recommendations, the most frequent were:
  - 1. Increase CBO involvement in PPS-level planning activities (such as workforce development committees, cultural competency and health literacy committees, project committees, the executive board, and more).
    - Recommended 10 times by 9 different organizations
  - 2. Include more frontline practitioners such as Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners, and Social Workers – in PPS-level planning activities.
    - Recommended 10 times by 2 different organizations
  - 3. Increase transparency by increasing access to critical documents, such as IA-annotated and adjudicated materials, PPS workforce development strategic planning documents, among others.
    - Recommended 9 times by 5 different organizations
  - 4. Increase funds flow to Community-Based Organizations.
    - Recommended 8 times by 8 different organizations
  - 5. Tie between: (i) Provide more workforce development for frontline practitioner positions; and (ii) hire more, or fund more frontline practitioner positions.
    - Each recommended 7 times by 7 different organizations
