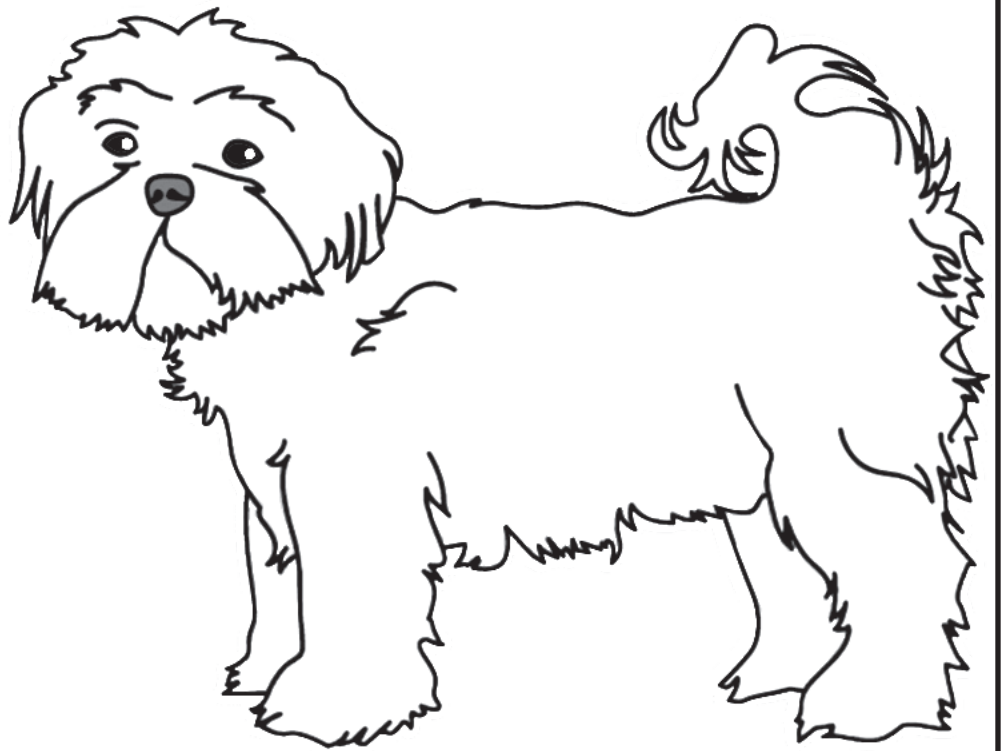

Walking with Daisy



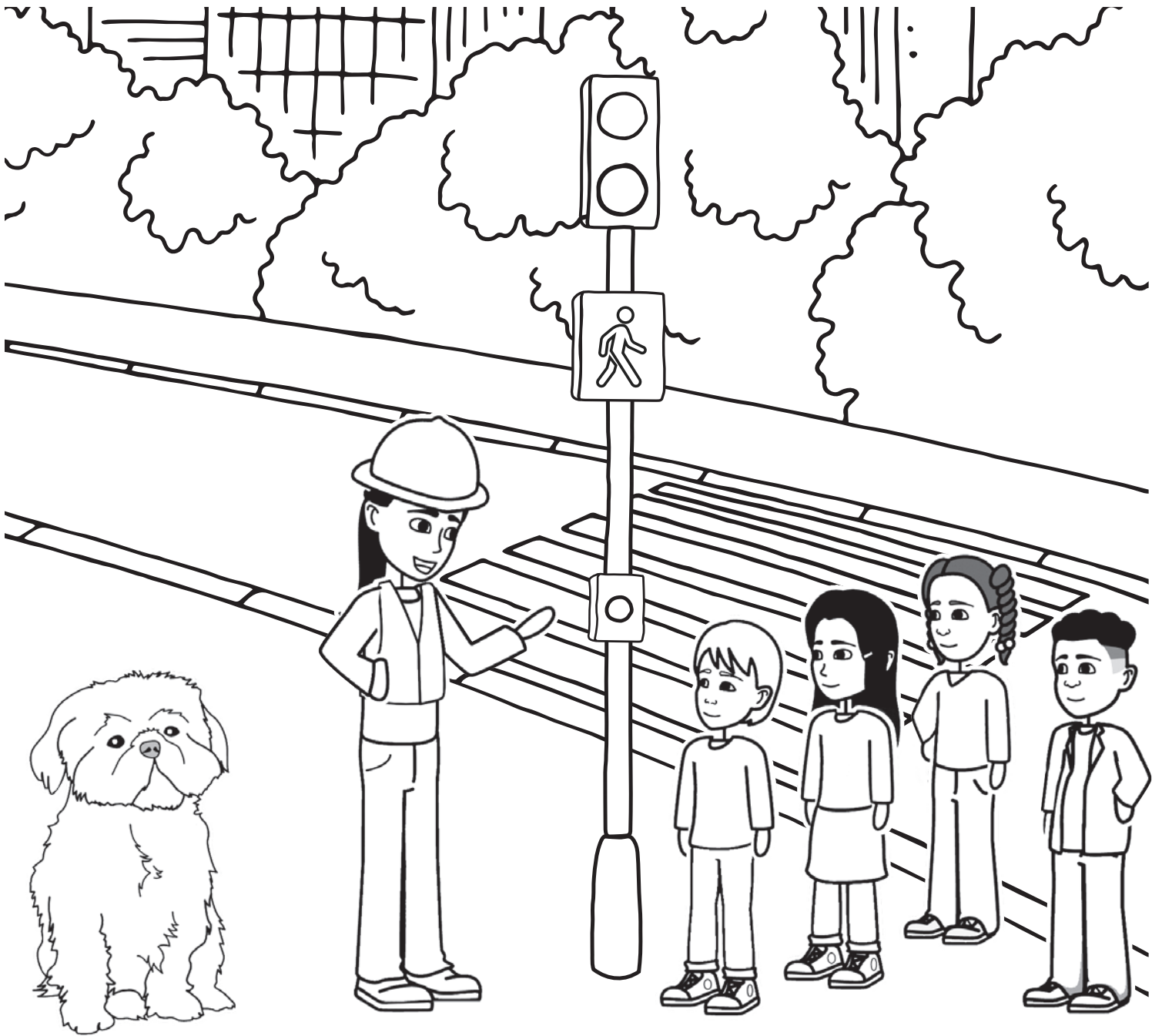

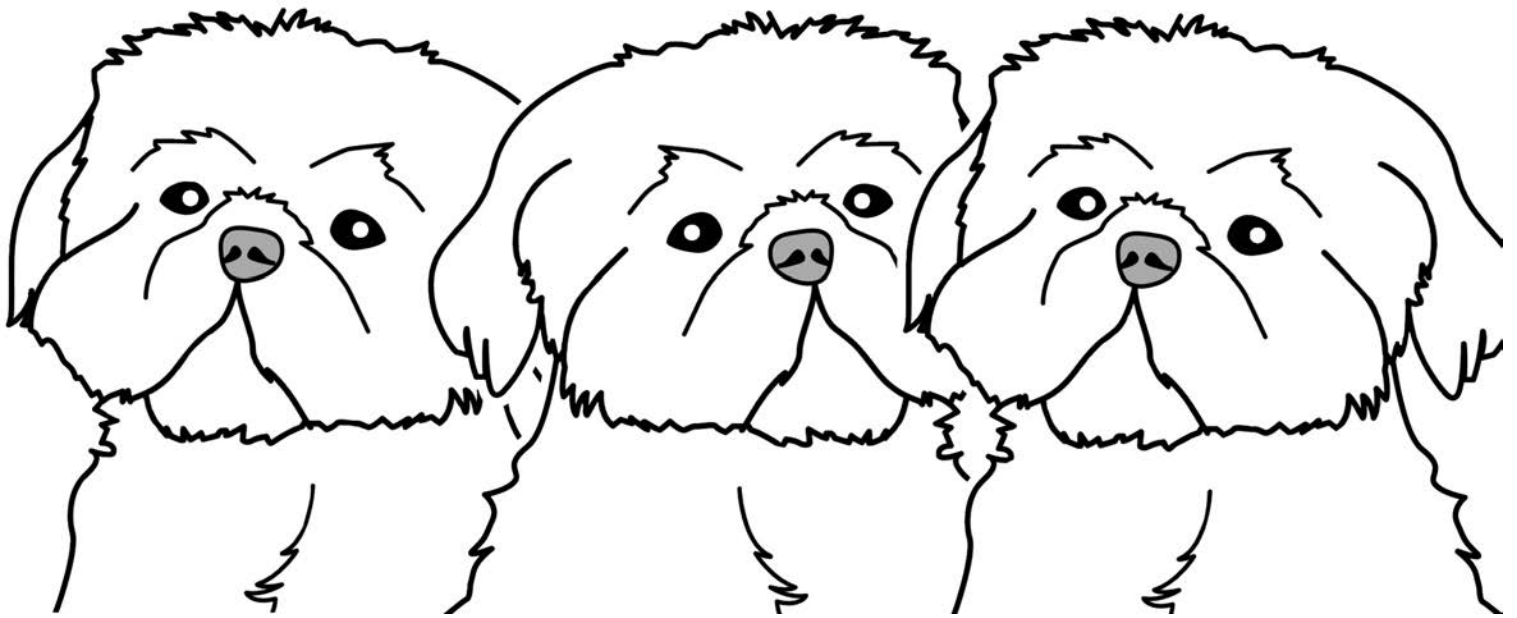


Hi! I'm Wanda, and this is my trusty sidekick, Daisy.

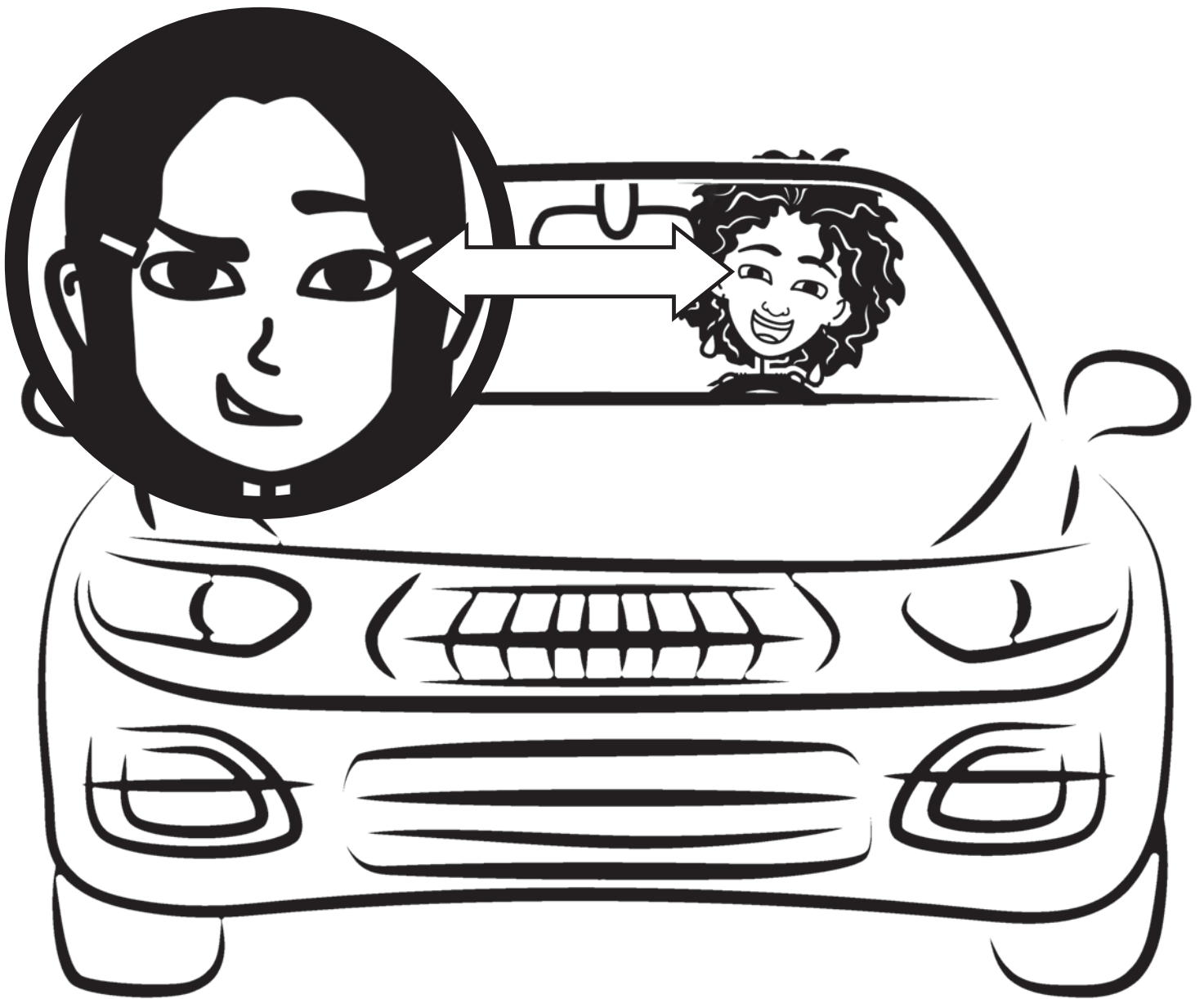
We want to help you be

Cross at a crosswalk. When there is a traffic light, push the button and cross when you see the walk signal. 



Look left, right, and left when you cross the street.



Make eye contact with drivers
when crossing the street.

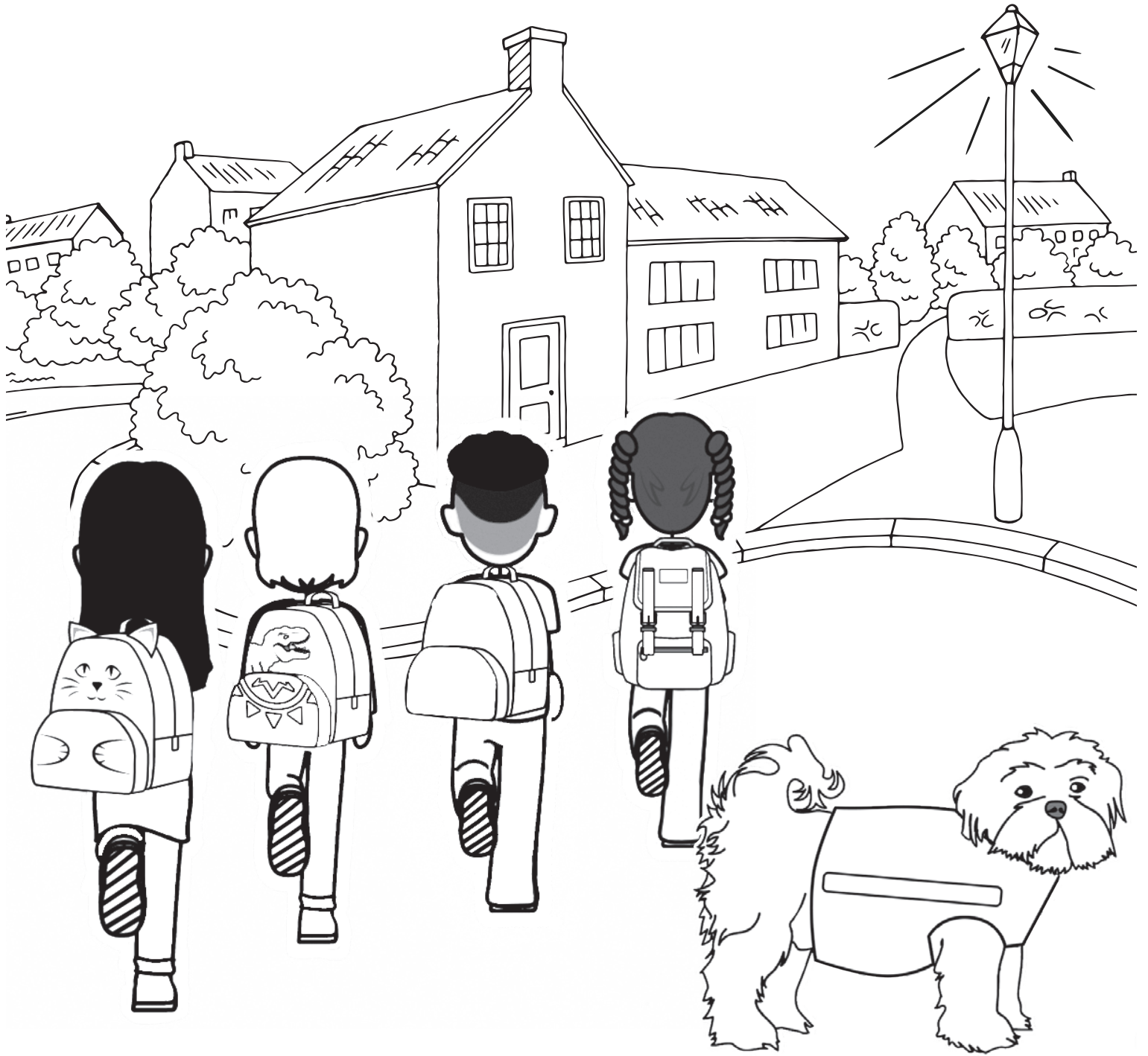


Look out for drivers pulling in or out

They may not see you.

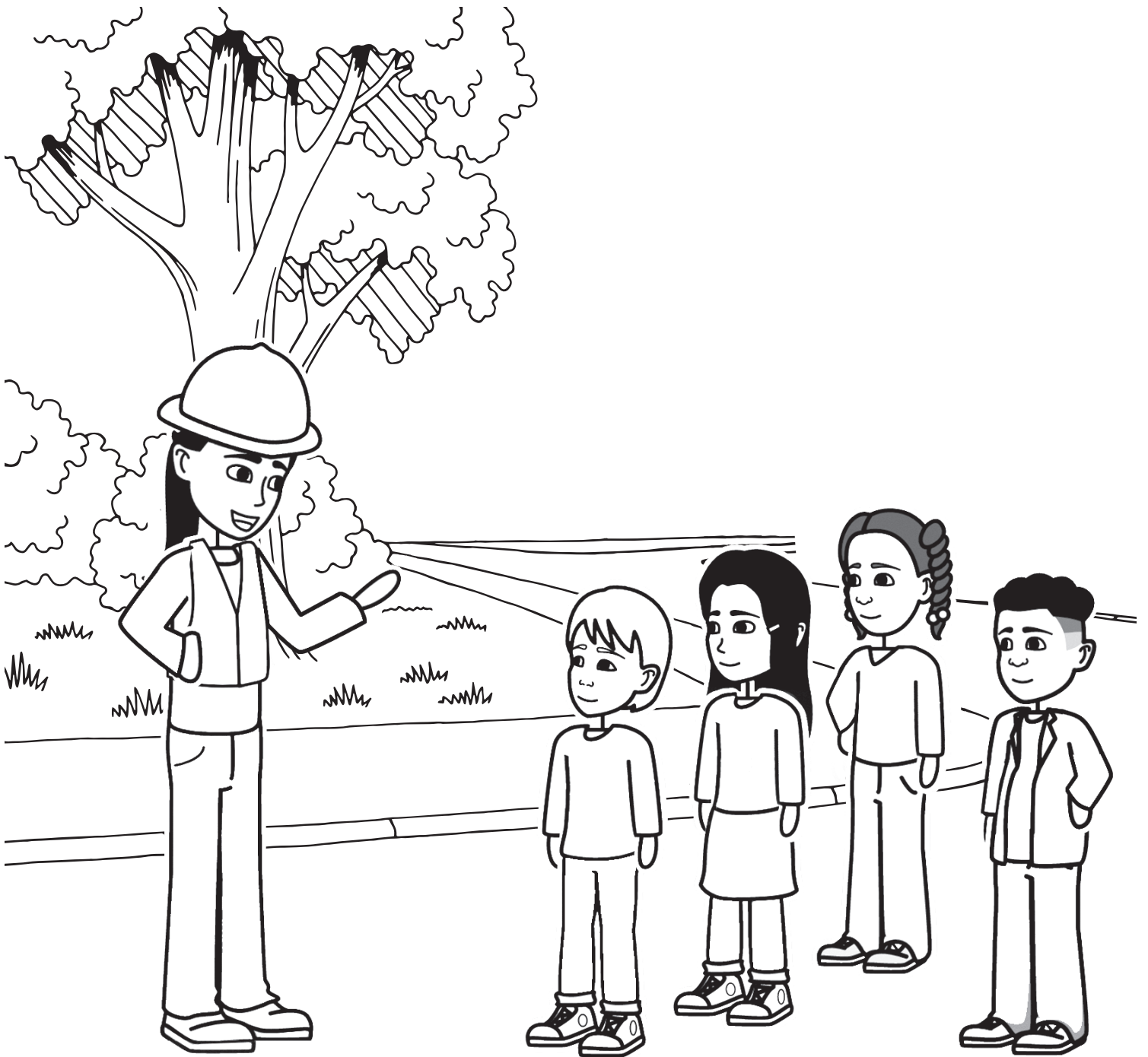


When there are no sidewalks, walk in a line facing traffic so you can see cars coming.



Wear light-colored or reflective clothing after dark.

Color the backpacks and Daisy's safety vest in **BRIGHT COLORS!**

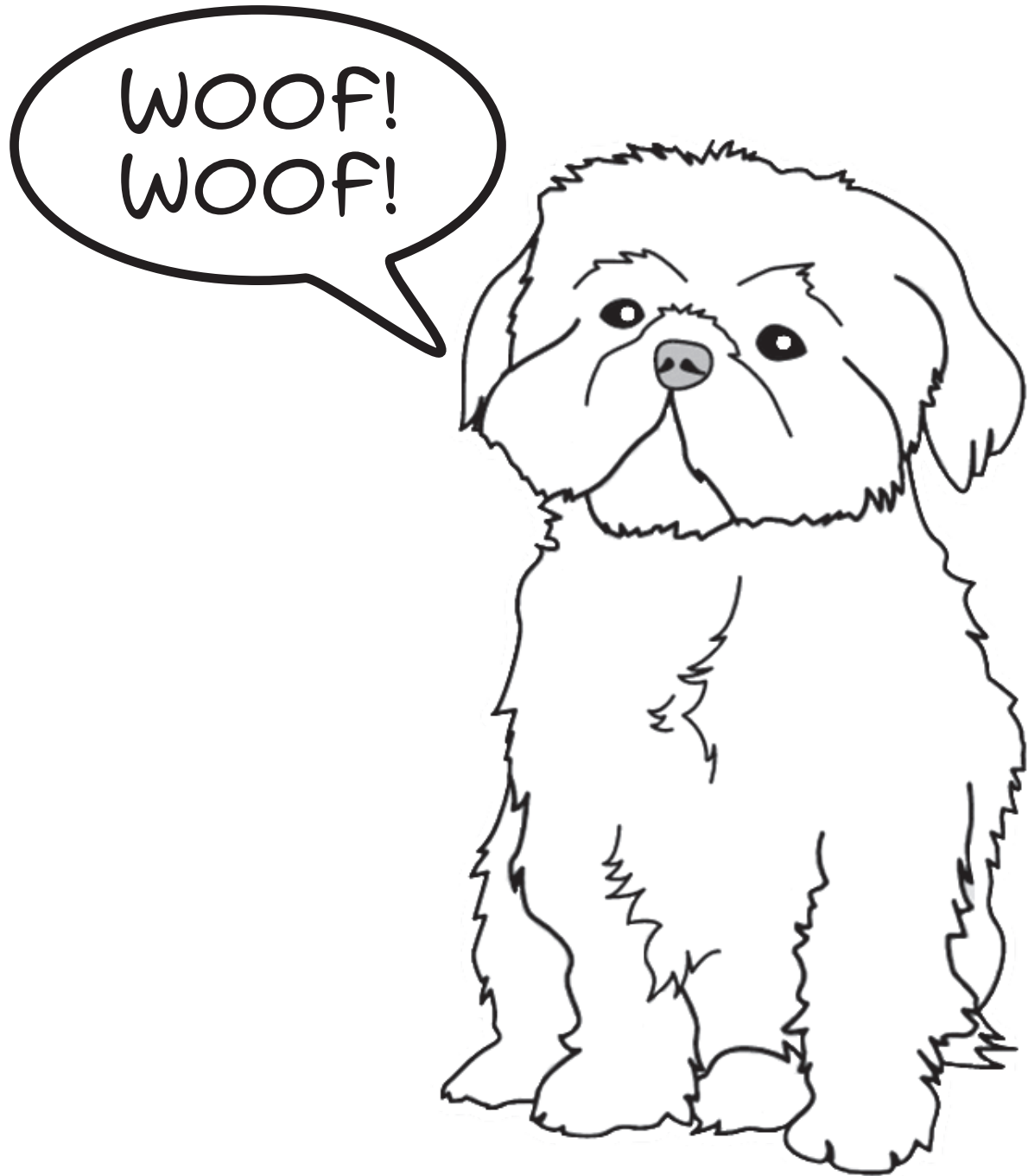


Pay attention when you're walking.
