

## SCREENING LIST OF ICD-9-CM CODES FOR CASE FINDING

Certain ICD-9-CM\* codes identify cases of neoplasms that are reportable to the New York State Cancer Registry. Casefinding procedures should include the review of pathology reports with the following codes: (The left column has the ICD-9 codes, and the right column has the corresponding SNOMED morphology codes/text descriptions, where applicable.)

### ICD-9-CM CODE

140.0 – 172.9	Malignant neoplasms (primary and secondary).
174.0 – 208.9	<b>Note: Malignant Neoplasms of skin (173.n) are not to be reported.</b>
225.0 – 225.4	Benign Brain and CNS tumors
225.9	<b>Note: The only reportable benign tumors are either CNS or intracranial.</b>
227.3, 227.4	Benign tumors of the pituitary and pineal glands
230.0 – 233.0 233.2 - 234.9	Carcinoma <b>in situ</b> of 230.0 - 230.9 Digestive Organs 231.0 - 231.9 Respiratory System 232.0 - 232.9 Skin (Only Melanoma, Hutchinson melanotic freckle and lentigo maligna.) 233.0 - 233.9 Breast & genitourinary system; <b>Note: 233.1 Cervix is not reportable.</b> 233.7 - Bladder 234.0 - 234.9 Other and unspecified sites
236.2 237.0-237.1 237.5-237.9 238.4 238.6-238.7	Neoplasms of uncertain behavior; borderline malignancy; low malignant potential; uncertain malignant potential- <b>only the following are reportable:</b> 236.2 – Ovary ( only 8442, 8451, 8462, 8472, 8473) 237.0 - Pituitary gland and craniopharyngeal duct 237.1 - Pineal gland 237.5 - Brain and spinal cord 237.6 – Meninges 237.7 – Neurofibromatosis (CNS only) 237.9 – Cranial nerves (tumors of peripheral nerves are not reportable unless malignant) 238.4 - Polycythemia vera 238.6 – Plasmacytoma; solitary myeloma (9731) 238.7 - Primary cutaneous lymphoproliferative disorder (9718), chronic myeloproliferative disease (9960), thrombocythemia (9962), myelodysplastic syndrome, refractory cytopenia with multilineage dysplasia, and panmyelosis are reportable. <b>Note : lymphoproliferative disease, NOS (9768); lymphoproliferative disorder, NOS (9970); and myeloproliferative disease, NOS (9975) are not reportable.</b>
239.6 – 239.7	Neoplasms of unspecified nature- <b>Note: The only reportable tumors of unspecified nature are either CNS or intracranial.</b> 239.6 – Brain 239.7 – Only cranial nerves, meninges, pineal gland, pituitary gland, and craniopharyngeal duct
273.2	Heavy chain disease (alpha, Gamma and Franklin’s disease)
273.3	Waldenstrom’s Macroglobulinemia
284.9-285.0	Specified anemias: <b>Note: Only refractory anemia (sideroblastic and non-sideroblastic (9980-9984)) is reportable.</b>
288.3	Hypereosinophilic syndrome (9964); Chronic eosinophilic leukemia
289.8	Acute myelofibrosis (9931)
