DRIVERS

Slow down or stop to yield to pedestrians crossing:

- At any intersections or crosswalks.
- At marked midblock crosswalks.
- When entering and exiting driveways, alleys, or parking lots.

Drivers must take care to avoid colliding with pedestrians.

PEDESTRIANS

- Slow down or stop for drivers when crossing outside of intersections or crosswalks.
- Obey traffic-control signals when crossing streets.

Pedestrians must allow enough time for the driver to see and react to them before leaving the curb.
