FFY 2023 DWSRF Intended Use Plan Amendment:

IUP Section 7.3: Disadvantaged Community (Hardship) Eligibility Criteria is amended to include the following:

- Additional subsidy from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), may not be used to forgive debt that was incurred prior to November 15, 2021, the enactment date of the BIL.

The New York State Department of Health has determined that the amendment is necessary, reasonable, and in the interest of protecting public health. Except as noted above, there are no other changes to the IUP as a result of this Amendment No. 1 of the FFY 2023 IUP.
