The Department of Perioperative services also has assistive leadership staff that support the day to day operations of running the OR, running the orthopedic service lines, assisting with the supply chain management for all supply inventory including implants as well as bone and tissue for surgical procedures. There is a SIS analytics administrator who oversees the block schedule for surgical time, utilization reports, turnaround time for OR and delays in surgical time. In addition, the SIS analytics administrator creates and modifies surgical schedule block time and supports the scheduler with booking cases as well as having the task of posting charges for OR use and supply and implants for surgical cases. There is a surgical registrar responsible for registering patients the day of surgery.
