**Description:** The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) Alzheimer's Disease Program (ADP) announces the opportunity for one not-for-profit organization with a statewide presence to act as the statewide resource on Alzheimer's disease and related dementia (ADRD) promoting statewide support services, providing disease education and advocacy on issues related to ADRD and increasing awareness. An annual award of \$232,000 will be provided contingent upon the availability of state funds and approval of the Office of the State Comptroller.

The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) Alzheimer's Disease Program (ADP), located within the Bureau of Community Integration and Alzheimer's Disease (BCIAD), is part of the Center for Aging and Long-Term Care Finances and Supports, Office of Aging and Long-Term Care. The ADP is responsible for implementing initiatives to support people living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia (ADRD) and their caregivers. The initiatives are based on evidence that demonstrates that providing an array of caregiver support services in the community helps to avoid unnecessary hospitalizations and emergency room visits, delays nursing home placement, and improves caregiver burden and mental health outcomes.

### Minimum Qualifications of Eligible Organizations:

- Applicant must be a 501c3, not-for-profit organization whose primary focus is advocacy, disease education, and support for individuals living with

Alzheimer's disease and related dementia;

- Applicant must be eligible to do business in New York State;
- Applicant must have a minimum of five (5) years of experience engaging and coordinating services with organizations whose primary mission is serving individuals living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia in all 62 counties;
- Applicant must have at least three (3) years' experience and an existing infrastructure in place to promote disease awareness and services related to Alzheimer's disease and related dementia in all 62 counties;
- Applicant must have a minimum of three (3) years of experience contracting with a government entity. Expected Activities: The funded entity will be expected to:
  - Work in conjunction with the New York State Department of Health Alzheimer's Disease Program (NYSDOH ADP) and the prime contractor of the Alzheimer's Community Assistance Program (AlzCAP) to promote awareness of Alzheimer's disease and Related Dementias (ADRD) across New York State and in all 62 counties.
  - Work in conjunction NYSDOH ADP and the prime contractor of AlzCAP to promote services to and for individuals living with (ADRD) and their caregivers across New York State and in all 62 counties.
  - Use the Healthy Brain Initiative Roadmap as a guide to engage in activities that reduce stigma and bias about cognitive decline, increase knowledge and skills of current and future workforce; increase knowledge about brain health, risk factors for dementia and the benefits of early detection and diagnosis; and increase public knowledge and use of services for people living with dementia and their caregivers across New York State through statewide education and advocacy efforts.
  - Engage New York State-based stakeholder groups such as Councils and Associations on issues related to ADRD and aging.
