JMHCP Webinar Background

- JMHCP is a cross systems collaboration with criminal justice and behavioral health for the purposes of reducing recidivism and supporting recovery
- JMHCP Technical Assistance includes training and consultation organized by Sequential Intercept Points
- Community Care Coordination A program that crosses all intercept points, which ensures access to high quality services and promotes recovery using a Care Coordinator who creates and supports implementation of Individualized Service Plans
- Community Care Coordination approach changing due to the the Affordable Care Act and NYS Medicaid Redesign
