Anyone in the Organizations above with Read-Only or Worker Roles have access to utilize the My Members screen filters and download a My Members file



What is contained in a My Members File?

There is a lot of information on a My Members File. Topics covered in today's webinar include:

- Managed Care Plan Name
- Segment Status
- Segment Begin and End Dates
- End Date Reason
- County of Fiscal Responsibility Description
- Medicaid Eligibility End Date



Where is the My Members Page?





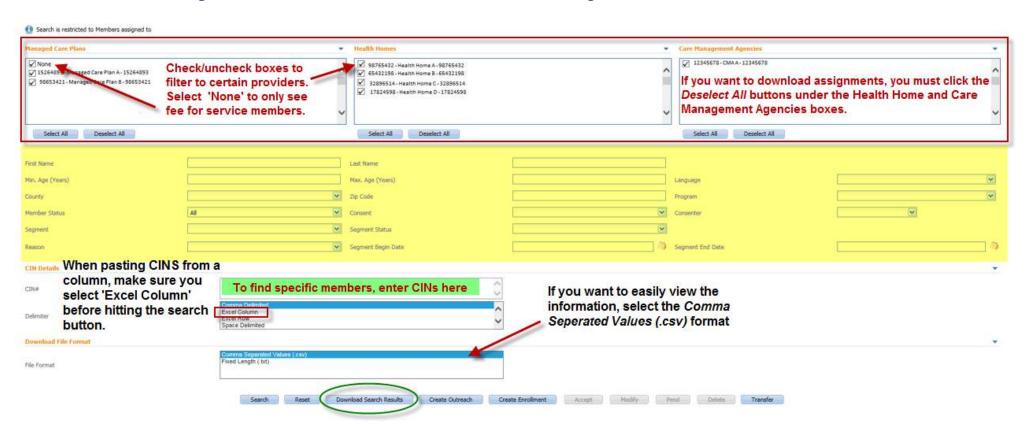
What is contained in the My Members screen?

- Contains all segments associated with your organization in the following statuses: active, closed, pended, pending active, pending canceled, pending closed, pending pended
- In addition, you can also pull down all open assignments associated with your organization by clicking **Deselect All** underneath the Health Home and the Care Management Agencies boxes.
- Use the filters to limit the types of segments/members included in the file download (filter Segment Status to pending active to isolate the segments that a HH needs to approve; use the min/max age boxes to locate members 18-21)
- This screen allows for some "Bulk" actions (must first filter Member Status to 'Current')
 - If filtered to assignment, you can use **Create Outreach** to create outreach segments with the same begin date for all checked members
 - Filter Segment Status to pending active and select all members to approve and move segments to the active status

What do I do next?

- Left click on the Button to the far right of the line and select "Download File Content"
- You will be asked if you want to open or save XXX file. Your options are Open, Save, or Cancel
- Select Open
- This will open a CSV file in excel
 - If you would like to save this file to your desktop you must go to "File", select "Save As", Select the destination to save the file. You can rename the file and change the format to excel.



The file

- The My Members file has 47 columns in total, from A to AU.
- Columns F, Q, R, S, T, U, AG, and AJ are important to look at and are explained in the following slides.



Column F contains Managed Care Plan Name

The Managed Care Plan Name is important to verify what Plan a member is in. If a member is enrolled in a FIDA, PACE, or FIDA-IDD they are NOT eligible for outreach, to enroll, or to continue enrollment in the Health Home Program.



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Columns Q-U contains information about the segment

- Column Q Segment status distinguishes if the segment is Active, Pended, or Closed. This is important to check as a member may have been disenrolled in your EHR but still appears as Active in the tracking system. A correction to the tracking system will need to be made. If a segment is a Pending status (Active, Closed, Pended, or Cancelled), then it means a CMA without auto approval created a segment in the tracking system and that the HH needs to approve the segment.
- Columns R and S house the segment Begin and End dates. This is important to check to make sure your EHR and the MAPP HHTS have the same dates.
- Column T Contains the segment End Date Reason. Reasons for ending a segment in MAPP HHTS should be the same reason as your EHR. DOH may conduct random audits for End Date Reasons and ask your organization to provide proof of what has been entered into the tracking system doesn't flow correctly. (i.e. An Enrollment segment is ended with a reason "Individual deceased". A new Outreach segment is opened the next month with the same HH and the same or different CMA. DOH will ask the HH why Outreach is being attempted for a member that is deceased?)



Column U – This field is no longer used. Please disregard any data in this field and look to the Consent
download file to access consent information for your organization's members.

Columns AG and AJ – County of Fiscal Responsibility and Medicaid Eligibility End Date

- These two columns should be checked at the same time. If there is a County listed in AG but AJ is blank this indicates the member's Medicaid end date is 12/31/9999.
- If there is a County listed in AG and there is a date in AJ this date is when the member's Medicaid will end. Care Managers should be aware of this date 3 months prior to help members recertify their Medicaid.
- If there is not a County listed and instead the column read "Not Medicaid Eligible" this
 means the member is no longer eligible for the HH program.
