Signing the HCBS/LOC Determination Assessment

Conducting the HCBS/LOC Assessment

The HCBS/LOC assessment is completed in two steps.

- **Step 1**: Complete the HCBS/LOC assessment with the child/youth and family. This includes responding to every data item in the assessment and <u>signing and finalized the assessment.</u>
- Step 2: Review and complete the assessment outcomes with the family. This includes reviewing the eligibility status and <u>signing and finalizing the assessment outcomes</u>. It is essential that the outcomes be completed. Signing and Finalizing the HCBS/LOC assessment outcomes triggers the K-codes to be entered for the child/youth's Medicaid file so HHs, C-YES, MCOs, and others are aware that the child/youth is HCBS eligible. Additionally, the one year of HCBS/LOC Eligibility does not begin until the Outcomes have been signed.

I. Step One – Completing the HCBS/LOC Assessment

The HCBS/LOC assessment is a tiered assessment with a set of questions to determine Target Population, Risk Factors, and Functional Determination. This assessment is used to determine HCBS eligibility. Upon completion of all the data items in the assessment, the assessor will sign and finalize the HCBS/LOC assessment. These steps are required before viewing and working in the assessment outcomes node that outlines the child/youth's eligibility.

Sign/Finalizing the HCBS/LOC Assessment:

- Open the appropriate assessment.
- Select the Sign/Finalize node.
- The assessor must review that all items are complete by using the check required tool at the Sign/Finalize node of the HCBS/LOC assessment.

II. Step 2 – Reviewing HCBS/LOC Eligibility Assessment and Completing Assessment Outcomes

After the HCBS/LOC assessment is Signed/Finalized, the system will evaluate the responses within the completed HCBS/LOC assessment to determine the child/youth's eligibility status for HCBS. This status is displayed in the Assessment Outcomes node. The table below outlines the status and description of the status.

Status	Description of the Assessment Outcome
Yes, eligible	HCBS eligibility period begins for a period of one year, once the Outcomes are signed and finalized
No, not eligible	The child/youth is not eligible but can reapply at any time. NOD is sent after the Outcome is signed and finalized

Reviewing the Results - No Medicaid ID Found for Child/Youth (C-YES Assessors)

If the child/youth does not have a valid Medicaid ID found at the Identification Information Node, the assessor will not be able to sign the Assessment Outcomes. Although the outcomes cannot be signed, the assessor can <u>still</u> share this information with the family. Subsequently, the family can share the eligibility status with the LDSS/HRA to expedite the process for completing the Medicaid application process.

III. Summary on Completing the HCBS/LOC Assessment Outcomes

- A. In summary, the assessor can only complete the Assessment outcomes if the following conditions are met:
 - The HCBS/LOC Determination assessment is signed and finalized.
 - A Medicaid ID has been entered for the child/youth.
- B. The **REASONS** why signing and finalizing the HCBS/LOC Assessment Outcomes are necessary:
 - The assessment outcomes must be reviewed and discussed with the child/youth/family and to issue the appropriate Notice of Decisions.
 - Notifies NYS DOH Capacity Management to assign an HCBS slot.
 - Triggers the K-codes to be entered for the child/youth's Medicaid file so HHs, C-YES, MCOs, and others are aware that the child/youth is HCBS eligible.
 - This allows HCBS providers to serve and claim for services they provide for children/youth who have appropriate K-codes
 - Additionally, the one year of HCBS/LOC Eligibility does not begin until the Outcomes have been signed.
