About the Campaign

PrEP Aware Week, 2021 is a public education campaign supported by the New York State Department of Health AIDS Institute. From October 25 – 31, 2021, a host of virtual and inperson events and activities will occur with the objective of boosting awareness and knowledge of PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis) as a highly effective HIV prevention and sexual health tool that is available to priority populations.

The theme for *PrEP Aware Week*, 2021 is "My PrEP." and the official campaign website is www.PrepForSex.org. The campaign features images and videos of eight new ambassadors from across the state. Collectively, they reflect a variety of races, ethnicities, gender identities and sexual orientations. These individuals were selected based on their strong social media presence and connection with the communities that they represent – utilizing their personal platforms to advocate for PrEP and sexual health.

How to Participate

This toolkit includes everything that you'll need to participate in *PrEP Aware Week*, 2021 on Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram. We've included social media messages, graphics, videos, and a GIF for you to download and share on your social media channels.
