Community Outreach And Linkage To Care For Active Substance Users

Low-threshold clinical services in community based settings to provide immediate health care and social service needs of HIV infected and at-risk youth (13-24). Services include: HIV counseling and testing, risk reduction services, linkage to primary care, pregnancy testing, family planning and reproductive health care, STD screening and treatment, and screening for TB and hepatitis.

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Harm Reduction

Individual- and group-level interventions (single-session and/or multiple-session) that address harms related to substance use—particularly the risk of HIV/STD/Hepatitis C transmission from unsafe drug-using and/or unsafe sexual behaviors. Interventions combine client-centered risk reduction education and counseling to help drug users recognize the consequences of substance use and set achievable goals toward positive behavior change. Referrals and navigation to substance use treatment and other supportive services are provided as needed.

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Health Home HIV Care Management

Health Homes provide comprehensive care management to high need Medicaid recipients with chronic illnesses, including persons living with HIV. HIV Care Management agencies provide access to, coordination, and integration of physical, behavioral, and community support services to PLWHA in order to improve each individual's health and health care.

HIV Education/Risk Reduction

Short term individual and group level HIV education and risk reduction activities to enhance the knowledge base, health literacy, and self-efficacy of HIV+ persons to access HIV medical services and remain healthy. Services are intended to increase participation in health care, enhance secondary HIV prevention, and decrease the risk of HIV transmission.

HIV/STD/HCV Prevention Education/Risk Reduction Services

Health education and risk reduction education and/or counseling services are provided to individuals and/or groups and range from targeted outreach to prevention counseling to group interventions to broad community level interventions (CLI). Individual-level interventions (ILI) provide individualized health communication, health education, and risk reduction counseling to assist clients in creating plans for individual behavior change and making ongoing appraisals of their own behavior. These interventions may consist of one or multiple sessions. Group-level interventions (GLI) may include peer education and support to promote and reinforce safer behaviors. Prevention interventions delivered to groups may be single or multiple sessions, and often provide interpersonal skills training to negotiate and sustain appropriate behavior change. CLIs seek to reduce risk behaviors by changing attitudes, norms, and practices of community members, and may include a combination of intervention types (e.g., outreach, health communication, public information) or units of delivery (e.g., individual, group, community)

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LGBT Health And Human Services

LGBT focused health, wellness and human services to increase access to healthcare. Services include risk reduction education, mental health and substance use prevention, supportive services, advocacy, social support, LGBT cultural competency and education for health providers.

Medical Care

These organizations provide professional diagnostic and therapeutic services rendered by a physician, physician's assistant, clinical nurse specialist, nurse practitioner or other licensed practitioner in an outpatient, community-based or office based setting. Services may include case management, diagnostic testing, early intervention, preventive care and screening, medical examination, medical history taking, diagnosis and treatment of physical conditions, prophylaxis and treatment of opportunistic infections, prescribing and managing medication, education and counseling on health issues, and other related services.

Provision of targeted screening for sexually transmitted diseases such as Chlamydia, gonorrhea and syphilis and linkage to appropriate follow up services including medical care, partner services and prevention counseling.

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Supportive Housing Services

Supportive housing services for People Living with HIV/AIDS who are homeless, unstably housed or at risk of losing housing. Services include short or long term rental assistance, and/or emergency financial assistance, housing retention services, independent living skills development, housing placement assistance, non-intensive case management, supportive housing coordination and psychosocial services. Income eligibility and other eligibility requirements may apply.

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Syringe Exchange

Provides new, sterile syringes without a prescription to active injection drug users, steroid and hormone users and others who inject substances to prevent transmission or acquisition of blood borne diseases. Provision of syringes includes the offer of short counseling on various safer injection practices, disposal and referral to needed services.
