MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Current license and registration to practice medicine in New York State, AND board-eligible or board-certified in a medical specialty AND either a master's degree in Public Health or one-year experience in a public health program.
PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS	Preferred candidates will have three years of professional work experience in public health or preventive medicine within a health department, academic or clinical setting; familiarity with communicable disease surveillance and outbreak response activities; and excellent organizational and communications skills. At least one year of experience overseeing a public health program, including supervision of staff.
RESPONSIBILITIES	The Public Health Physician 2 (PHP 2) will serve as Bureau Director for the Bureau of Communicable Disease Control (BCDC). BCDC has five major programs that are responsible for the control and prevention of over 60 communicable diseases through investigation, surveillance, research and education. The PHP2 will provide leadership and direction to the Bureau's programs and will supervise unit/program managers. Major responsibilities include, but are not limited to: oversee, coordinate and provide technical supervision of all Bureau disease surveillance, control and epidemiologic activities; develop and implement programs' objectives, goals and priorities; provide medical input and expertise required to direct and oversee Bureau programs; deploy staff to address disease outbreaks or unusual disease occurrences; develop and implement plans to insure local readiness to respond to bioterrorism and other public health threats; research and develop policy and clinical guidance documents on new and emerging pathogens for use by DOH staff, local health departments (LHDs), and health care providers; provide consultation to health care professionals, including LHD representatives, physicians, nurses and other stakeholders; oversee the design and implementation of epidemiologic research studies to assess the effectiveness of the surveillance, investigative and intervention methods used; analyze legislation, statutes and regulations that affect Bureau programs; serve as a medical expert consultant to the Division of Epidemiology and Executive staff and other State and Federal agencies regarding communicable disease issues; and foster collaborative relationships with public health, clinical and other partners..
