<b>PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS</b>	Experience in obstetrics/gynecology and/or women's health; experience in public health programs or services related to improving women's health; experience in quality improvement efforts including assessing data, implementing clinical bundles and policy and program development in conformance with current standard of clinical practices; experience in facilitating or working in collaboration with groups of professionals and/or communities to improve health outcomes; excellent writing and communication skills.
<b>RESPONSIBILITIES</b>	The incumbent will serve as a Medical Director in the Division of Family Health (Division) and work with the Division leadership team to provide health and medical expertise in topics, programs and initiatives related to women's health. Principle responsibilities will include: developing and providing input into public health policy on those areas and initiatives impacting women's health; providing direction and support to improving and enhancing health equity for all women; overseeing the formation and operation of the Advisory Council on Maternal Mortality and Severe Maternal Morbidity and working with the Division leadership team in other efforts to address maternal mortality and morbidity including but not limited to providing clinical input for efforts related to maternal mortality and morbidity reviews, perinatal regionalization of birth centers and perinatal hospitals across New York State, improving access to perinatal care in rural areas of the state, perinatal depression, opioid use in pregnancy, reproductive health, adolescent health and a wide range of issues and initiatives related to women's health. The incumbent will also serve as a member of the Division's leadership team regarding program direction such as the Maternal and Child Health Services Block Grant Title V State Action Plan and Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program and collaborate with the Department's Office of Health Insurance Programs on topics impacting women's health; develop briefing documents, respond to requests for information, legislative proposals or to drafted bills and other written and verbal documents proving clinical expertise and guidance and keep abreast of developments on the federal level for potential impact on women's health services in New York State, and represent the Department on state and national committees, groups and panels on issues related to women's health.
