Appointee must maintain full licensure and registration to practice medicine in New York State after appointment. Appointee must be eligible for and maintain eligibility for full and unconditional participation in Medicaid and Medicare programs and must maintain eligibility after appointment.</p> <p>Appropriate certification by an American Medical Specialty Board and one year of post certification experience in that specialty can be substituted for four years of general experience.</p>
<b>PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS</b>	Board certification in Geriatric Medicine and/or Certification as a Medical Director (AMDA), and experience in a long term care facility. Understanding and commitment to the Home's core values and philosophy that residents come first is also a criterion for selection.
