FFY 2022 DWSRF Intended Use Plan Amendment:

DWSRF No. 18214: Village of Waterloo, Seneca County – The project cost as listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is increased to a total project cost of \$6,700,000 due to higher than expected construction costs.

DWSRF No. 18096: Town of Orleans, Jefferson County – The project cost as listed in the DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP) is increased by \$680,000. This increase is needed to allow for the project financing to be converted from the short-term financing to a long-term financing for the actual project costs.

The New York State Department of Health has determined that the amendment is necessary, reasonable, and in the interest of protecting public health. The amendment will not adversely affect any project on the IUP Project Annual List above the subsidized funding line. Except as noted above, there are no other changes to the IUP as a result of this Amendment No. 4 of the FFY 2022 IUP.

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
