

WIC Infant Cereal Rebate System Invitation for Bids

AMENDMENT #2

The following revisions are hereby incorporated into the Invitation for Bids document:

1. Page 10, Section C.4.a, third paragraph in this section is revised to read as follows:

If the contractor introduces a new federally WIC eligible infant cereal during the contract period, an announcement of such must be communicated to the DOH as soon as is practical for the contractor prior to inviting orders for the product.

2. Page 11, Section 4.c, first sentence in this section is revised to read as follows:

Remit to the DOH a rebate per container for all WIC-eligible 8 ounce infant cereal produced by the contractor prior to or during the contract period and issued by the New York State WIC program during the contract period.

3. Page 11, Section 4.d, first paragraph in this section is revised to read as follows:

Remit to the DOH a rebate per container for all infant cereal newly approved for issuance by the NYS WIC program on or after the contract effective date. The DOH reserves the right to determine whether any of the WIC-eligible 8 ounce infant cereals produced by the contractor at the time of bid submission or any new infant cereal introduced by the contractor during the term of the contract will be approved for use in the New York State WIC program. In the event that an existing or new infant cereal is approved by the New York State WIC program during the contract term, the rebate for the added product will be computed as follows:

4. Page 11, Section 4.d.ii. is revised to read as follows:

Apply the relevant discount percentage to the lowest truckload wholesale price of the newly-approved product in effect on the date that the Department approves the cereal. The result will be the rebate for the newly-approved infant cereal.
