OTHER PROGRAM QUESTIONS

1. To get teenagers involved in family planning activities, what type of parental consent is needed—active or passive consent?

Educational programming related to family planning can be provided consistent with the organizational and/or educational facility requirements on consent. Family planning services can be provided consistent with New York State law.

FISCAL/BUDGET REQUIREMENTS

2. Can we “hire” a “subcontractor” to come to our facility to do family planning activities? If so, can we pay for a subcontractor for staff time only? Van mileage? Fuel expenses?
