Q1. I understand what it means to "provide" appropriate and necessary services; what does it mean to "arrange for" appropriate and necessary services?

A1. Applicants must demonstrate the ability to either directly provide, or arrange for the provision of appropriate and necessary services. This means both practical (identify clinical providers, make appointments, assure transportation) and financial arrangements (payment for clinical services) for appropriate and necessary services. The appropriate and necessary services must include: Diagnosis and Assessment (this is a clinical function); Patient Management and Care (this should include medical management, care management, and information and referral for social and support services); Training, Education, and Consultation (these are services provided to primary care providers, other professionals, caregivers, families and paraprofessionals); and serve as a Clearinghouse of Alzheimer's Disease and Other Dementias Information.

Q2. Will there be electronic forms that are able to be filled out, without the need to retype the information?

A2. Yes, Word versions of the Applicant Cover Sheet and Workplan will be added to the NYS DOH web site where the RFA is posted.

Q3. Does the format of the workplan follow the format provided in the application or do we use the past formats?

A3. This Request for Applications is for a new, competitive five year grant cycle and therefore the instructions and forms included in the RFA should be used.
