The NYSDOH is hereby amending the RFP for Technical Assistance to Small Public Water Systems (FAU Control #071217027) to further clarify the scope of services required for Task E (Develop Technical Products for Individual PWS).

Task E requires the development of at least 2 water system infrastructure mapping products per contract year and at least 8 other technical products (including, but not limited to: written standard operating procedures, emergency response plans, and asset management plans) per year as described in the original RFP.

Water system infrastructure mapping is intended for small municipalities with old and undocumented infrastructure. The contractor's selection of the specific systems must be approved by the NYSDOH. The intended scope is to map a small municipal water system with a population less than 3,300 people. The map should meet the needs of the water system and may include mapping sources, transmission lines, treatment works, distribution lines, valves, hydrants, storage tanks, etc. The maps should be delivered to the water system in an electronic format (ArcView, ArcReader, or equivalent).

The NYSDOH is requesting two prices for this task: one price for system infrastructure mapping deliverables and one price for all other types of deliverables. A revised Price Proposal Submission Form Annual Details form is attached. Please ensure the prices for system infrastructure mapping and for all other Task E deliverables are clearly differentiated.

The NYSDOH is hereby amending the RFP for Technical Assistance to Small Public Water Systems (FAU Control #071217027) to clarify the scope of services in Task D (Provide TA Training to PWS).

Task D requires six (6) technical assistance training sessions (as described in the RFP) to be offered each contract year. The training sessions must be the equivalent of full-day sessions (at least 6 NYSDOH-approved contact hours per day). The contractor may elect to offer 12 half-day sessions or some combination of each in consultation with NYSDOH. The total training requirement is 36 contact hours per contract year.
