- 3. Within Section D.4.3, Executive Summary, bidders are asked to “include a ‘roll-out’ plan that describes each phase and include a timeline showing how the transportation management functions will be implemented in each region.” Similarly, in Section D.4.5, Project Implementation Work Plan, bidders are asked to “provide a brief work plan for the three year contract term that includes a date specific timeline for implementation of the solicited activities that supports the start date listed on the cover page of the FAS. Include with each goal/objective the expected completion date, and person(s) responsible for implementation.” These sections seem repetitive. Due to the page limitations set forth by the FAS, will the Department consider omitting the requirement to describe the roll-out plan and implementation timeline within the Executive Summary and instead require this information only in Section D.4.5?**

The “roll-out plan” in Section D.4.3., Executive Summary, should be a brief plan description within the page limits of the Executive Summary. A timeline is not required in this section, as it is required in Section D.4.5, Project Implementation Work Plan. See FAS Amendment #1 on the DOH website www.health.ny.gov/funding.
