Reimbursed at a per 15-minute unit rate

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


What percentage of the total maximum reimbursement amount (\$1500/\$1350) should be 26 and dedicated to the reimbursement of doula support for labor and delivery services?






If you are a doula, on average, how many perinatal (prenatal and postpartum periods) 26 $\stackrel{26}{\sim}$ doula visits do you have with a client?

Proposed Reimbursement Structure Options - Original

Service Type	Service Amounts Reimbursed Options	NYC reimbursement rates	ROS reimbursement rates
Perinatal Service: Prenatal or postpartum doula support	Option 1: Up to 8 visits @ 30-mins/visit (4 hrs) Option 2: Up to 48 units @ 15 min/unit (12 hrs) Option 3: 3 prenatal <u>and</u> 3 postpartum visits @ 60 min/visit (6 hrs) Option 4: Up to 40 units @ 15 min/unit (10 hrs)	\$100/visit \$20.83/unit (\$83.33/hr) \$166.66/prenatal visit, \$133.33/postpartum visit \$16.25/unit (\$65/hr)	\$90/visit \$18.75/unit(\$75/hr) \$150/prenatal visit, \$120/postpartum visit \$14.63/unit (\$58.50/hr)

Perinatal Service: Prenatal or postpartum doula support	Up to 24 units (15 min./unit)	Up to 6 visits	28%	NYC: Up to \$425 ROS: Up to \$382.50
Labor and Delivery: In-person doula support during labor and birth	1 encounter		65%	NYC: \$975 ROS: \$877.50
Postpartum Provider Accompaniment: Accompany client to perinatal provider visit within 6 weeks of delivery	1 encounter		7%	NYC: \$100 ROS: \$90

Medicaid Updates & Telehealth Policy

- Medicaid Telehealth Policy: most recently updated February 2023, will apply to doula services benefit
