Proposed Training and Work Experience Pathways

Training Pathway

- 24-hour minimum training in all required competencies
- Doula support provided at a minimum of three births

OR

Work Experience Pathway

- 30 births or 1000 hours of doula experience within the last 10 years
- Testimonials of doula skills in prenatal, labor and postpartum care

Both Pathways

- Basic HIPAA training
- (TBD Alternate education regarding parenting
 - support/child welfare system)
 - Adult/Infant CPR
- Age 18 or older
- Liability Insurance

Both Pathways: Revalidation

Attestation to completion of continuing education in required competencies and CPR requirements

Doula Pilot Enrollment Transition Proposal

- Doulas <u>currently</u> active and enrolled in the pilot program:
 - Will remain enrolled as Medicaid providers initially
 - All will need to revalidate by February 28, 2025
- Ongoing revalidation will occur every 5 years and is required of all Medicaid-enrolled providers.
- The transition of pilot-enrolled doulas will assist in establishing network adequacy.

- Medicaid policy and program team will have a dedicated staff person to support the provider enrollment team and process and to serve as direct contact for doulas looking to enroll
