State Plan Amendment (SPA):

- The proposed SPA received Department of Budget/Chamber approval on 12/28/2023.
- The proposed SPA was advanced for federal approval to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) on 12/28/2023.

Proposed Statewide Benefit Enrollment Requirements

Both Pathways:

- Age 18 or older
- NPI Number
- Completion of general enrollment forms
- Completion HIPAA training
- Current certification in Adult/Infant CPR
- Current doula-specific liability coverage
- Meet either the Training or Work Experience Pathway Requirements
- Doula Qualifications Attestation Form(s) for specific pathway
- Completion of Electronic Form to be added to statewide Doula Directory

Training Pathway only:

• Copy of Doula Training Certificate(s)

Work Experience Pathway only:

 Submission of three different completed Doula Client Testimonial and/or Professional Recommendation Forms



Proposed Training and Work Experience Pathways



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Proposed NYS Medicaid Doula Competencies for <u>Training Pathway</u> to Meeting Criteria for Enrollment

Core Competencies (20 Hours of Training):

- Foundations on anatomy of pregnancy and childbirth
- Labor support techniques and nonmedical comfort measures
- Common medical interventions: risks, benefits, and decision-making
- Prenatal and postpartum education and support
- Lactation support, education and infant feeding
- Scope of practice

Broader Competencies (Four Hours of Training):

- Cultural awareness/humility and cross-cultural communication
- Health equity in medical field, especially reproductive health
- Person-centered and trauma-informed care
- Community-based knowledge and facilitating connection to resources



Proposed Fee for Service Reimbursement Structure

Service	Visit Allowance	Per Visit Reimbursement	Percent of Total Reimbursement	Amount of Total Reimbursement
Perinatal Service: Prenatal or postpartum doula support	8 visits	NYC: \$93.75 ROS: \$84.37	50%	NYC: Up to \$750 ROS: Up to \$675
Labor and Delivery: In-person doula support during labor and birth	1 encounter	NYC: \$750 ROS: \$675	50%	NYC: \$750 ROS: \$675

MMC Plans are encouraged to match or exceed the FFS rate
