## **B.** Drug Utilization Reviews

The DUR Board will review the following topics and, if applicable, recommend clinical criteria and/or interventions to ensure appropriate utilization:

- 1. Opioid utilization as related to the SUPPORT Act.
- 2. Antipsychotic utilization in children as related to the SUPPORT Act.
- 3. Opioid and Antipsychotic concurrent utilization as related to the SUPPORT Act.
- 4. Leukotriene Modifier utilization in the treatment of asthma.

## C. Clinical Editing Updates

The DUR Board will be provided information associated with current clinical criteria and/or interventions for:

1. Utilization of antiretroviral combinations (for the treatment of HIV/AIDS) and associated drug interactions.
