



## Announcing the Launch of the CANS-NY 2.0 for Children's Health Home

After an extensive analysis of 7 years of child-specific data and 18-months of collaboration with the Health Home Serving Children and State agency partners, the CANS-NY 2.0 will launch within the Uniform Assessment System (UAS) in November 2023. In anticipation of the upcoming launch, the CANS New York Technical Assistance Institute has prepared a brief video (CLICK HERE) to illustrate the processes and rationale that lead to the updated tool and care management decision support models.

In preparation for the launch of the new tool, all certified CANS-NY assessors will be required to complete a Booster training, which consists of two web-based videos that provide a detailed comparison of CANS-NY and CANS-NY 2.0: one for the CANS-NY 2.0, ages 0-5 version and one for the CANS-NY 2.0, ages 6-21 version. The Booster training will be required of all certified assessors by November 30, 2023.

A new CANS-NY 2.0 web-based certification course has been developed and will replace the former CANS-NY certification course starting on November 1, 2023. New assessors that require certification on or after November 1, 2023, must take the new CANS-NY 2.0 certification course. For currently certified assessors, the annual web-based certification course featuring the new CANS-NY 2.0 will be required no later than upon the assessor's recertification due date. Assessors may choose to take the course earlier than their recertification date, but it is not required.

The changes to the CANS-NY tool will also be reflected in the live virtual trainings conducted by the CANS New York Technical Assistance Institute beginning on October 31, 2023. The content for the <u>CANS-NY Introductory</u> training, the <u>CANS-NY Supervisory</u> training, and the <u>Building Engagement</u> training has all been updated.
