

### **MAPP HHTS Release 3.6 Updates**

The release is tentatively scheduled for deployment on March 16, 2021. Information regarding the MAPP HHTS Release 3.6 webinar that details the system changes and enhancements, will be distributed as we get closer to the implementation date.

### **MAPP HHTS Release 3.6 System Changes and Enhancements**

- Add age restrictions for A/C Indicator on segments. This will change the A/C indicator on a segment based on the members age, should the provider not end and create a new segment when the child ages out of HHSC.
- Expand OMH data feed to bring in additional information, including HH+ data.
- Changes to the HML. This will include adding additional information such as service date, name and CIN when review completed billing on screen. Additionally, an option to respond “unknown” to the Adult Home plus question will be available and will function similarly to responding “No” to this question.
- Adding a HH/CMA flag that would allow the HH or CMA to be able to bill at the HH+ rate. Providers without HH+ designation would not be able to bill at this rate.
- Assessment Tab and Display Changes. This will include a reorder the current list in the assessment tab and a change to “sorted by”, to the most recent service date when displaying assessments.
- Assessment download will flag most recent CANs and HCBS for a member based on the signed and finalized date. The file will also now include HCBS eligibility information.
- Add supplemental data and create reports for providers identified as specialized HHs which will include some edits to billing logic, relating to specialized HHs.
- Ability for providers to identify and track members that have had a change in CIN.
- Create a new more inclusive download file to capture the most useful member information in one file.
