- The Tool is not designed to:
 - Calculate a reimbursement rate
 - Be used to make management decisions based on reimbursement

Components:

- CFR Schedule and Line Number
- Category used in Rate
- CFR Line Name Per CFR Manual
- 2015 CFR Data (Used in Rate Development) All 5 Services
- CFR Review Tool (Agency can edit for overview)
- Memo



RATE DEVELOPMENT - IRA

- Data should be entered from the CFR
- Room and Board supplement calculations have been deleted
- Hard Coded Elements:
 - -Minimum Wage
 - -3.25% DSP Compensation Increase
 - -Budget Neutrality Factor
 - -Budget Neutrality Factor for Hours

- -Statewide Average Hours
- -Acuity Factor
- -Regional Average Salaries
- -Regional Average Contracted Clinical Brick
