We are pleased to inform you that the PPS of The Jamaica Hospital has been awarded a DSRIP Design Grant Award.

The total amount of your award is \$500,000. The award may be paid in one or split into two equal payments at the Department's discretion. The first payment is scheduled for distribution on 8/22/2014 and is for \$250,000. The second payment is scheduled for distribution on 11/03/2014 for \$250,000 will be contingent on the receipt of acceptable deliverables. These deliverables will be to access progress towards the formation of the PPS and will include such items, but not limited to Community Service Need Plan progress, PAC formation and guidelines, governance structure for PPS, etc. A separate collection tool will be provided to you in the very near future to collect this information uniformly for all PPS's.


Additionally, the following conditions specific to The Jamaica Hospital need to be met:
