## Tier 1 CBO Engagement

Narrative description of current and future plans for contracting with Tier 1 CBOs.

<b>PPS Name:</b>	OneCity Health
<p><u>OneCity Health Community Based Organizations (CBOs)</u></p> <p>OneCity Health recognizes that services provided by CBOs are integral to the PPS in carrying out the goals of DSRIP and creating a sustainable model that appreciates the importance of a delivery system addressing the social determinants of health.</p> <p>In response to this survey, we have excluded partnering community-based providers with MMIS and NPIs, who are traditionally designated as CBOs by our PPS, in order to meet the Tier 1 CBO definition requested. It is important to note that the Tier 1 CBOs do not align with CBO designations within the Provider Import Tool (PIT), resulting in different cumulative funding amounts.</p> <p>The three partners identified in the CCHL role (column D) are representative of only Tier 1 CBOs who are conducting a cultural competency self-assessment, though many other of our community partners are participating. This assessment is designed to help identify opportunities to improve cultural competency within our network organizations.</p> <p><u>Additional Resources Provided:</u></p> <p>Beyond direct CBO partner payments, the PPS is engaged in several opportunities to provide technical assistance (TA) and capacity building to support the work of Tier 1 CBOs.</p> <p>As noted in the 1st Level tab, four (4) CBOs have been contracted to provide strategic advice to develop OneCity Health's non-Medicaid billing network and contracting strategy. We believe outside expertise and capacity (from existing partners) will enable OneCity Health to leverage local knowledge/relationships and incorporate best practices.</p> <p>OneCity Health continues to work with our care coordination vendor to provide training to CBO partners on key components of various DSRIP projects including those with community health workers (CHWs). Through our care coordination management system, we will be able to track key process measures and enable users to generate performance reports for tracking referrals from primary care to CHW agencies.</p> <p>We are currently in the process of identifying a single referral platform to be provided to partners across the PPS to allow providers in primary care settings to screen and make referrals to CBOs for services and for CBOs to provide feedback to the referring providers. This "closed-loop referral mechanism" is a vital component of creating a full continuum of care within an integrated delivery system.</p> <p>OneCity Health provides capacity building by leveraging existing and new resources available within the Central Services Organization. The implementation team and support desk perform a range of technical assistance activities to engage our partners and identify solutions on program and contract-related questions.</p>
