

RESOURCES**S/CC RESOURCE LEVEL**

Policy: A/Rs between the ages of 21 and 65, not living with their children under the age of 21, not certified blind or certified disabled, and not pregnant, must be eligible as an S/CC to receive Medicaid coverage. The Medicaid Resource Level is used to determine Medicaid eligibility for these persons.

Interpretation: To be eligible as an S/CC, an individual's or couple's resources for persons under age 60 must be equal to or less than the Medicaid Resource Level. (See **RESOURCES S/CC RESOURCE DISREGARDS**, **RESOURCES TIME LIMITED S/CC RESOURCE DISREGARDS**.)

An S/CC individual or couple with resources in excess of the appropriate resource level is ineligible for assistance. S/CC individuals can not spend down to attain Medicaid eligibility.

All resources are evaluated to determine their value and availability. **RESOURCES S/CC BUDGETING METHODOLOGY** contains information on the treatment of resources for S/CC persons.
