

**RESOURCES****S/CC RESOURCE LEVEL**

**Policy:** A/Rs between the ages of 21 and 65, not living with their children under the age of 21, not certified blind or certified disabled, and not pregnant, must be eligible for S/CC to receive Medicaid coverage. The Medicaid Resource Level is used to determine Medicaid eligibility for these persons.

**Interpretation:** To be eligible for S/CC, an individual's or couple's resources must be equal to or less than the Medicaid Resource Level. (See **RESOURCES S/CC RESOURCE DISREGARDS, RESOURCES TIME LIMITED S/CC RESOURCE DISREGARDS**)

An S/CC individual or couple with resources in excess of the appropriate resource level is ineligible for assistance. S/CC individuals cannot spend down to attain Medicaid eligibility.

All resources are evaluated to determine their value and availability. **RESOURCES S/CC BUDGETING METHODOLOGY** contains information on the treatment of resources for S/CC persons.
