Who should get an updated COVID-19 vaccine this fall?

~	Everyone 6 months and older & 2 months since last vaccine
~	Children 6 months through 4 years & getting the vaccine for the first time = 2 doses Moderna vaccine or 3 doses Pfizer vaccine
~	5 through 11 = 1 dose of updated Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least 2 months since the last dose
<u></u>	12 and older who have been previously vaccinated = 1 dose of
	either Pfizer or Moderna updated vaccine
V	12 and older who have not been previously vaccinated = 2 doses of either Pfizer or Moderna updated vaccine
