## **Removal of Endotracheal Intubation from AEMT Level**

## I. PURPOSE

To update protocols related to endotracheal intubation for AEMT providers.

## II. UPDATE

The following Collaborative Advanced Life Support Adult and Pediatric Patient Care Protocols have been updated removing endotracheal intubation from the AEMT scope of practice:

Updated Policy: Oxygen Administration and Airway Management | Pages – 180-181
Removed endotracheal intubation from AEMT level

These changes were brought forward as a motion and approved by the SEMAC and SEMSCO at the September 2022 meeting. The changes are consistent with the National Educational Standards for AEMT providers. EMS providers are strongly encouraged to review these protocol changes to ensure compliance with these changes.
