Description:

The Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) will be offering this course. Participants completing this program will be able to properly perform patient triage, decontamination, treatment and transportation in the event of exposure to chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive (CBRNE) weapons. The course consists of facilitated discussions, small group exercises, hands on activities and task orientated practical applications. Course participants will use both state- of-the-art adult and pediatric human patient simulators to promote critical thinking skills while utilizing RAPID- Care concept.

Course Objectives:

Demonstrate the skills necessary for proper detection and monitoring; triage and mass decontamination treatment and stabilization; self protection; and cross contamination prevention.

Prerequisites:

You must be a US Citizen to take this course.
