Dear Manufacturers, Distributors, and Importers of Controlled Substances:

Enclosed is the **New York State Issued Formulation - Morphine Milligram Equivalent (MME) Conversion Table Guidance**, which describes how to calculate MMEs to report annual data to the Department of Health (DOH) as required by the Opioid Stewardship Act.
