

NEW YORK STATE MEDICATION DROP BOX PROGRAM

STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT

Law enforcement agencies must agree to abide by the below terms in order to participate in the New York State Medication Drop Box Program.

- The medication drop box must be located inside a law enforcement facility and permanently secured to the floor or wall.
- A law enforcement agent must be in visual contact with the medication drop box at all times.
- The Medication Drop Box Program is open to members of the public (i.e., households) only. It is not open to pharmacies, veterinarians, pharmaceutical businesses, or any entity other than a private household.
- Medications, including controlled substances, may be dropped off during the program's hours of operation only.
- A law enforcement agent must participate in the securing, transportation, and destruction of surrendered medications.
- All items surrendered must be destroyed at a municipal solid waste combustion facility approved by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. Most municipal solid waste combustion facilities charge an incineration fee.
- Medication Drop Box Program participants are responsible for costs associated with the destruction of surrendered items.
