

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Albany County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Albany County.
- Annually, 14 Albany County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 4 Occupants
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Albany County.
- Annually, 152 Albany County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 85 Occupants
 - 26 Pedestrians
 - 26 Motorcyclists
 - 11 Bicyclists
 - 3 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Albany County.
- Annually, 1,907 Albany County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,531 Occupants
 - 151 Pedestrians
 - 93 Unspecified Persons
 - 74 Motorcyclists
 - 41 Bicyclists
