

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Chautauqua County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Chautauqua County.
- Annually, 9 Chautauqua County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Chautaugua County.
- Annually, 43 Chautauqua County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 27 Occupants
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
 - 2 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Chautauqua County.
- Annually, 875 Chautauqua County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 704 Occupants
 - 58 Unspecified Persons
 - 52 Pedestrians
 - 39 Motorcyclists
 - 21 Bicyclists
