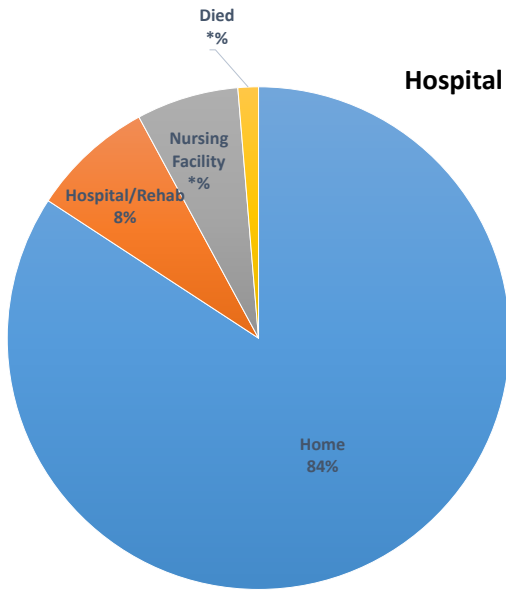


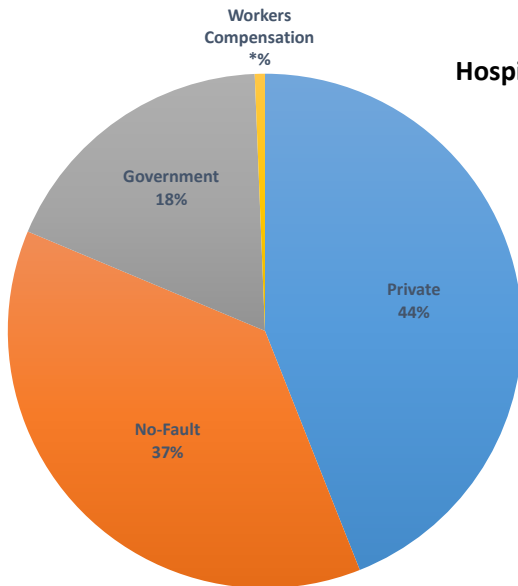
Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury  
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges  
Clinton County Residents, 2012-2014



**Hospital Discharge Disposition**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 25 hospitalizations

- 21 Were discharged to their home
- 2 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- \* Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- \* Died
- 0 Left against medical advice



**Hospitalization Charges**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$922.0 Thousand in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$405.6 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$344.1 Thousand charged to no-fault insurance
- \$166.4 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$\* Charged to workers compensation
