


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Clinton County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Clinton County residents.
- Annually, 10 Clinton County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Occupants
 - 2 Other Specified Persons

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Clinton County residents.
- Annually, 36 Clinton County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 28 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - 2 Unspecified Persons

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Clinton County residents.
- Annually, 647 Clinton County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 553 Occupants
 - 39 Unspecified Persons
 - 22 Motorcyclists
 - 20 Pedestrians
 - 13 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
