


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Columbia County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Columbia County residents.
- Annually, an average of six Columbia County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Occupants
 - 2 Unspecified Persons

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Columbia County residents.
- Annually, an average 60 Columbia County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 42 Occupants
 - 8 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - 4 Unspecified Persons

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Columbia County residents.
- Annually, an average 392 Columbia County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 344 Occupants
 - 18 Motorcyclists
 - 18 Unspecified Persons
 - 10 Pedestrians
 - 3 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
