


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Delaware County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Delaware County residents.
- Annually, eight Delaware County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 4 Unspecified
  - 3 Occupants

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Delaware County residents.
- Annually, 41 Delaware County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 32 Occupants
  - 4 Motorcyclists
  - 2 Pedestrians
  - 3 Unspecified

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Delaware County residents.
- Annually, 392 Delaware County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 308 Occupants
  - 48 Unspecified
  - 18 Motorcyclists
  - 14 Pedestrians
  - 2 Pedal Cyclists
  - 2 Other
