



Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits Dutchess County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Dutchess County residents.
- Annually, 28 Dutchess County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 14 Unspecified
 - 10 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Dutchess County residents.
- Annually, 419 Dutchess County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 313 Occupants
 - 46 Motorcyclists
 - 33 Pedestrians
 - 20 Unspecified
 - 6 Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Dutchess County residents.
- Annually, 2,544 Dutchess County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2,188 Occupants
 - 190 Unspecified
 - 74 Pedestrians
 - 69 Motorcyclists
 - 20 Pedal Cyclists
 - 2 Other
