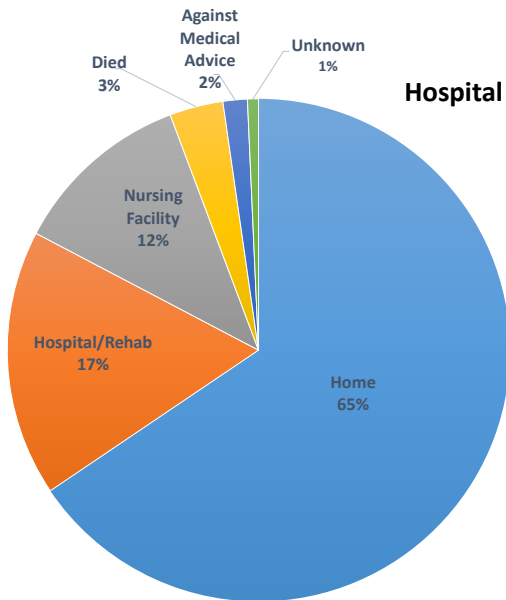


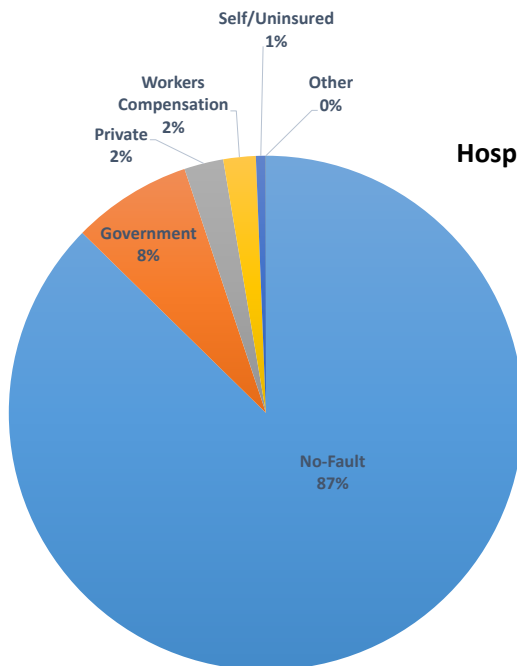
Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges Erie County Residents, 2012-2014



Hospital Discharge Disposition

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 426 hospitalizations

- 279 Were discharged to their home
- 73 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 49 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 20 Left against medical advice
- 15 Died



Hospitalization Charges

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$18.6 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$16.3 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$1.4 Million charged to public funds
- \$459.1 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$379.2 Thousand charged to workers compensation
- \$115.3 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
