


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Erie County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related death for Erie County residents.
- Annually, 60 Erie County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 26 Occupants
 - 15 Unspecified Persons
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 7 Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Erie County residents.
- Annually, 694 Erie County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 454 Occupants
 - 105 Pedestrians
 - 77 Motorcyclists
 - 33 Pedal Cyclists
 - 24 Unspecified Persons

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Erie County residents.
- Annually, 8,780 Erie County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7,418 Occupants
 - 466 Pedestrians
 - 427 Unspecified Persons
 - 263 Motorcyclists
 - 197 Pedal Cyclists
 - 9 Street Car
