


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Essex County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Essex County residents.
- Annually, eight Essex County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Occupants
 - 3 Unspecified
 - 2 Other

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Essex County residents.
- Annually, 19 Essex County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 13 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - * Other

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Essex County residents.
- Annually, 214 Essex County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 172 Occupants
 - 20 Unspecified
 - 13 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Pedestrians
 - 2 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
