



Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Franklin County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Franklin County.
- Annually, 5 Franklin County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - 0 Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Franklin County.
- Annually, 18 Franklin County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 11 Occupants
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - 0 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Franklin County.
- Annually, 307 Franklin County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 246 Occupants
 - 25 Unspecified Persons
 - 18 Motorcyclists
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 5 Bicyclists
